

How to get there









TRAVEL COSTS

Please plan your travel from your place of origin to the venue of the activity in Berlin and return according to the travel limit shown in the table below. Your travel costs will be reimbursed up to the limit, if you spend less you will get what you spent. We always reimburse to the account of sending organizations, so not directly to participants. Reimbursements of travel costs can only be done upon full attendance of the training course.

Travel and health insurance




Every participant must bring their European Insurance Card.
